The Reading Fall Street Faire is an annual community event bringing together local restaurants, retail businesses, community groups, and town government for a fun-filled family-friendly day. There is something for everyone... children's area with all types of fun such as bouncy castles, face painting, and games... numerous vendors selling food, arts and crafts, jewelry, candy, and every other imaginable delight... community groups sponsoring all types of fun and offering services... an antique and classic car show... the Fall Street Faire Five-K road race in the morning hours... continuous entertainment, music, and dance performances throughout the faire... and free flu shots too!



The Fall Street Faire Five-K race is part of the Reading Fall Street Faire and it is a wholesome, community-based road race. The race starts at 10:00 AM and there will be a pre-race warm up provided by the Pure FIT Team at 9:15 AM. There will be an awards ceremony at Washington Park immediately after the race. On race day you can register in person via cash or check and pick up your bib at Washington Park from 8:00 – 9:30 AM. And if you're not running you can stop by and cheer your friends and neighbors on as they run for the roses!

The Antique & Classic Car Show is one of the most popular events at the faire. Do you have an antique or classic car tucked away in your garage? Enter that beauty and who knows... the judges may give you a prize! Vehicles will be on display at the Municipal Parking Lot behind CVS from noon until 3:00 PM.
