Oak Street

Construction resumes on March 16th

Dear Neighbor:

Next week, March 16th, the MWRA and our contractor, P. Calliacco Inc., will resume work to complete the installation of a new 36 inch water pipeline at West Street and Oak Street. It is expected that the duration of remaining work is less than two weeks.

The MWRA needs to install this pipeline in advance of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation's roadway reconstruction project on West Street in order to minimize the impacts to their schedule.

Oak Street will be closed at the West Street intersection so access will only be through the Pine Ridge end of the street. Police details, will be provided for traffic and pedestrian safety. Work will be performed Monday through Friday from 7AM-5PM.

This Massachusetts Water Resources Authority project is Phase I of building a new transmission service pipeline called the Northern Intermediate High Pipeline which will travel through the towns of Stoneham, Reading, Wakefield, and Woburn. The transmission pipeline will improve water supply to this service area
