Petition and Agreement
Permanent Type Sidewalks

(I) (We), the legal owner(s) of the property located at _____ do hereby petition the Board of Public Works (now the Board of Selectmen) of the Town of Reading, Massachusetts for permission to construct a permanent type sidewalk within the public way abutting (my) (our) property and by (my) (our) signature(s) hereon do agree to do all work according to the following rules and regulations at no cost to the Town of Reading.

1. The petitioner agrees to construct the sidewalk according to the lines and grades established by the said Board, in accordance with the Standard Specifications of the said Board and within the time limit set forth in the agreement.
2. The petitioner agrees to follow all directives issued by the said Board.
3. The petitioner agrees to employ only such reputable contractors as are approved by the said Board.
4. The petitioner agrees to assume all public liability for the sidewalk both during construction and for the interval between construction and the acceptance of the sidewalk by the Town Meeting.
5. The petitioner agrees that either he or his contractor will file with the said Board prior to construction a certificate of insurance covering public liability in an amount and of a kind satisfactory to said Board.
6. The petitioner agrees to properly light and barricade the work during construction and shall immediately after construction clean up the site and leave it in "broom clean" condition.
7. The petitioner agrees not to, at any time, interfere with the proper flow of traffic on the traveled way abutting the work.

- 8. The petitioner agrees that the number of days between the start of the construction and the completion thereof will not exceed fourteen calendar days.
- 9. The petitioner agrees that the project will be complete within a period of six months.
