



## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

The Town of Reading and its contractor, SB General Contracting, Inc., will be replacing the Water Main on your street. This is part of the Town wide water distribution system improvement program. Construction is scheduled to begin April 2015, weather permitting.

The Street will be closed during construction hours and detours are expected. Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes.

The roadway will be open to local residents however; excavation will limit access to driveways within the active construction area. Prior to construction, residents will be notified when the area in front of their house will be affected so that vehicles can be moved and not blocked in by construction.

**During this project, on your day for collection of rubbish, all rubbish must be at the curb by 6:30 A.M. We also ask that no cars be parked on the street, to help facilitate this construction project.**

The excavation will be filled in and the street made passable at the end of each day.

A temporary water main will be constructed along both sides of the street, in the sidewalk/gutter area to provide water service to residences during construction. Residences will be connected from this main to an outside faucet with drinking water-approved hoses. To connect the temporary water service, it **will be necessary for the Contractor and Water Department personnel to gain access to your basement** to turn off the valve at the water meter. You will be contacted shortly to schedule this work.

All residences will be notified prior to any planned water service shut downs with water service being restored as soon as possible.
