**ONLINE VOTER REGISTRATION NOW AVAILABLE IN READING**

***Visit The Town's Website to Register to Vote***

Online voter registration is available through a portal launched by Secretary of the Commonwealth William Francis Galvin's office and linked through the Town of Reading's website. This important advancement will make registration easier and more convenient as well as cut costs relating to the printing of voter registration forms.

Reading residents can apply online by visiting the town's website at [www.readingma.gov/elections](http://www.readingma.gov/elections) or by going directly to Secretary Galvin's website at [www.sec.state.ma.us](http://www.sec.state.ma.us) and clicking the "Massachusetts Register to Vote Online" button to access the online application system. Any Massachusetts citizen who has a valid identification card issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles will be able to use the online system to apply to register to vote, update their address or change their party enrollment.

Reading citizens who do not have identification issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles can still complete an application online which they can print, sign and mail or hand-deliver to the Town Clerk's Office. With the Presidential Primary only months away in the spring of 2016, now is the time to check your voter registration status and make any updates as necessary.
