



Textile Recycling

Did you know.....

Only 15% of textiles are recycled, the remaining 85% are thrown into household rubbish and become part of the waste stream? What a waste!

Here are some of the items in your home that are considered textiles:

Every item of clothing, (including underwear)

Hats/mittens/gloves/scarves

Socks, shoes, sneakers, flip-flops, (even one)

Sheets, pillows, blankets, table linens

Belts, purses

Robes and slippers

Rugs, shower curtains and drapes

Towels and washcloths

Stuffed toys and stuffed animals

Yarn, cut cloth, etc

All these items can be recycled.

It doesn't matter what condition they're in, everything is sorted and graded when it's received.

Please do not recycle:

- Wet materials
- Soiled materials (stains are ok, dirty clothes are not)

By recycling textiles, we reduce rubbish disposal costs; provide clothing, training, and jobs for others; and protect the environment.
