### The Lights are ON At Memorial Park!

Now let's hope that Mother Nature cooperates and gives us smooth perfect ice and as little snow as possible. Ice permitting, the lights will go on seven nights a week at approximately 5:00 PM to approximately 10:00 PM. The Recreation Division has a few safety tips that make sense and that should be observed even when skating on a man-made rink:

- ✓ Residents should test the ice on iffy weather days to make sure the ice is solid.
- ✓ Always remember that ice-covered water is never completely safe.
- ✓ Always skate with friends and let others know when you will be on the ice and when you will return.
- ✓ Understand that wind chill factors are relative temperature guides.
- ✓ Carry a whistle or other noisemaker to alert people if you are in distress.
- ✓ Dress in layers and add extra clothing for the head, neck, sides, and groin as these are the primary heat-loss areas.
- ✓ Be polite and courteous to any other people who are using the rink.
- ✓ Always be cautious when ice skating.
